## What are we going to do?

We will be widening the pavement on Woodbridge Road in Guildford and making this a shared use pedestrian and cycle path. We will also be replacing the protective vehicle barrier on the bridge.

These works will start in the May half term and continue into the August school holidays.

These works will include a westbound lane closure between Woodbridge Road and Woodbridge Meadows, this will be in place 24 hours.

The U-turn facility will be closed for the duration of the works; this is due to worker and driver safety. There is not enough space on the road with the works to keep it open.

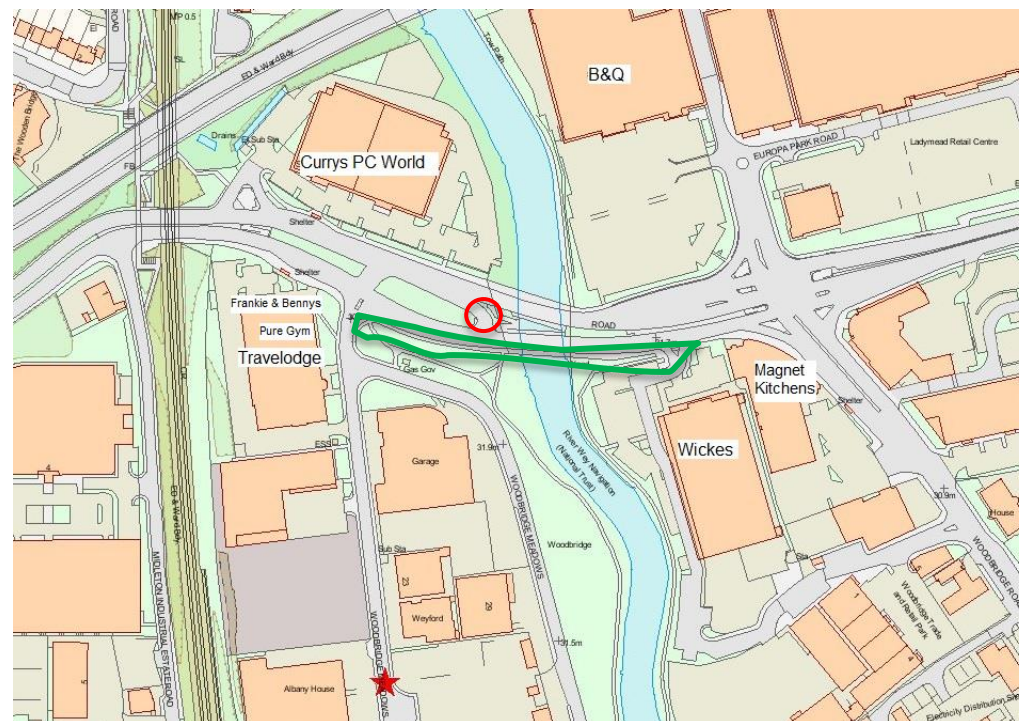
We will have teams working on site during the day and night, Monday to Friday. This has been done to reduce the overall duration and impact on the area.

This work is part of the A25 cycle corridor scheme to create a continuous off-road cycle facility along the route.

Traffic management to include:

- 24/7 lane closure between Woodbridge Road and Woodbridge Meadows from 28 May to 25 July
- 24/7 Closure of U-turn facility on A25 Woodbridge Road
- Night time closure of Woodbridge Road (westbound) on the following dates
  - 28 May
  - 25 July
  - 7 August to 22 August (week days only)
- 15 July – 2 August - Night time closure of Woodbridge Meadows
- Diversions to be put in place where needed.
