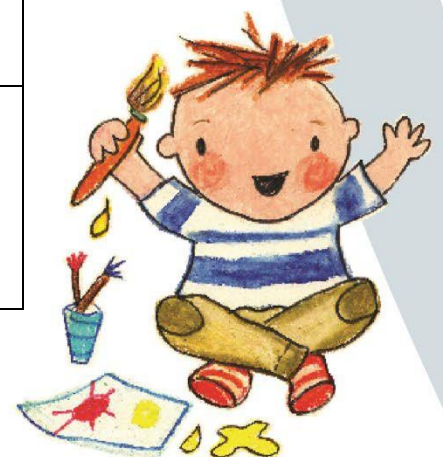
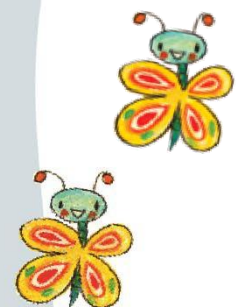

What happens next

Usually, we will only contact you at the beginning of the term your child turns two years old. So don't worry if you don't hear from us before then.

After we check your details with the Department for Work and Pensions and confirm that you are eligible, we will send you a letter. Take this letter to your chosen childcare provider. They will offer some settling-in sessions and agree a start date for your child. When your child starts, the childcare provider will claim funding directly from us.

We store the information you give in a secure database. We follow the General Data Protection Regulations 2018. To find out how we use your personal data, who we may share it with and how to remove your consent at any time, read the Early Years Funding Privacy Notice.
