Chertsey Lane (A320) Staines-Upon-Thames
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2020

On 09 December 2020 Surrey County Council (“The Council”) Made the above mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act (“The Act”) 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Chertsey Lane (A320) Staines-Upon-Thames that is crossed by the rail over road bridge known as “Chertsey Lane Railway Bridge” and for a distance of 20 metres on either side.

The Order is required to allow bridge examination works to be carried out by, or on behalf of Network Rail within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 1 night between the hours of 9pm and 5am within the 18 month period of operation of the Temporary Order that commences on 09 January 2021.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed, and the Temporary Closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access for the emergency services, pedestrians and dismounted cyclists will be maintained at all times. No sole access will be affected. All other traffic will be required to follow the signed diversion route.

The vehicular diversion route will be via (B3376) Thorpe Road; (B3376) Thorpe Lea Road; (B388) Thorpe Lea Road; (B388) Mill House Lane; (A320) Staines Road; and (A320) Chertsey Lane or this same route in reverse.
