

NOTICE

The Surrey County Council Connaught Avenue (D3238) Ashford Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2021

On 26 May 2021 Surrey County Council Made the above mentioned Temporary Traffic Order under Section 14(1) and 15(8)(b) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“The Act”), the effect of which will be temporarily prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of the western carriageway of Connaught Avenue (D3238) Ashford as extends from its junction with (D3237) Station Crescent to a point approximately 40 metres south westwards along (D3238) Connaught Avenue. The alternative route will be via the eastern carriageway of Connaught Avenue.

The Order is required to allow for a welfare unit and site storage facility to be installed on site for footway reconstruction works on Station Crescent by, or on behalf of Surrey County Council within the length of road described in this notice. This Temporary Traffic Order commences on 30 May 2021 and continues in force the provisions introduced by “Surrey County Council Connaught Avenue (D3238) Ashford Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Notice 2021” issued under S14(2) of The Act on 10 May 2021.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed, and the temporary closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. No access will be maintained through the closure area and all traffic will be required to use the alternative route. No Sole Access will be affected.
