

NOTICE

The Surrey County Council Markedged Lane (D1157) Merstham/Chipstead Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2021

On 30 June 2021 Surrey County Council Made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) and 14(7) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to –

- (a) prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in the entire length of Markedged Lane (D1157) Merstham/Chipstead; and
- (b) suspend “The Surrey County Council Markedged Lane (D1157), Merstham Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2020” in its entirety.

The alternative routes will be via High Road; Blackhorse Lane; A217 Brighton Road; A217 Reigate Hill; Back Lane; Tower Lane; and Gatton Bottom; or Gatton Bottom; Tower Lane; Back Lane; A217 Reigate Hill; A217 Brighton Road; Babylon Lane; and High Road.

The Order is required to facilitate telecoms cabling and/or maintenance works to be carried out by, or on behalf of JSM Group within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 3 nights between the hours of 7pm and 6am within the 12 month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 14 July 2021.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed, and the temporary closure and suspension will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access for the emergency services, residents, pedestrians, and cyclists will be maintained at all times.
