**The Surrey County Council**  
**Orestan Lane (D265) Effingham**  
**Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2021**

On 21 July Surrey County Council Made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Orestan Lane (D265) Effingham as extends from its junction at the mini roundabout with (C43) Effingham Common Road / The Street to a point in line with the western boundary of the property known as “The Plough Inn”.

There is no applicable alternative route.

The Order is required to facilitate new electrical connection works to be carried out by, or on behalf of UK Power Networks within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 3 days between the hours of 8am and 6pm within the 12 month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 02 August 2021.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure, which is anticipated to be in operation 24 hours per day, will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access for residents within the closure area, pedestrians, and cyclists will be maintained at all times.
