Guildford Road (B3012) Frimley Green
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2021

On 14 September 2021 Surrey County Council Made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Guildford Road (B3012) Frimley Green as extends from its junction with (X3082) Acorn Avenue to its junction with the access to the property known as "Berisay".

Alternative Route – Guildford Road; Gole Road; A324 Downey Hill / The Green / Guildford Road / Aldershot Road / Pirbright Road; A323 Guildford Road / Church Road / Ash Street / Aldershot Road; A332 Blackwater Valley Road / Blackwater Valley Route; A325 Frimley By-Pass / Portsmouth Road; Frimley High Street; Church Road; and Frimley Green Road or this same route in reverse.

The Order is required to facilitate jetting and drainage works to be carried out by, or on behalf of Centurion Traffic Management within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 3 days between the hours of 11.59pm and 5am within the 12 month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 25 September 2021.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed, and the temporary closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access to premises within the affected length of road including access by emergency vehicles to these properties will be maintained at all times, as will access for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists.
