Rock Hill (Hambledon Road) (C31) Hambledon
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2021

On 28 July 2021 Surrey County Council Made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Rock Hill (Hambledon Road) (C31) Hambledon as extends from its junction with (D168) Church Lane to its junction with (D166) Woodlands Road.

The alternative route will be via Hambledon Road; Station Lane; A286 Church Road; A283 Petworth Road; Lane End; and Malthouse Lane or this same route in reverse.

The Order is required to facilitate critical mains water valve repairs to be carried out by, or on behalf of Morrisons Utility Services within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 1 week between the hours of 8am and 5pm within the 12 month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 09 August 2021.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure, which is anticipated to be in operation 24 hours per day, will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access for residents and businesses within the closure area, the emergency services, pedestrians, and cyclists will be maintained at all times.
