

## **NOTICE**

### **The Surrey County Council Crocknorth Road (C44) East Horsley Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2021**

On 29 September 2021 Surrey County Council Made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Crocknorth Road (C44) East Horsley as extends from its junction with (D259) Green Dene to its junctions with Public Bridleway No.103 East Horsley and Public Bridleway No.132 East Horsley. Alternative Route – Green Dene; A246 Guildford Road; Beech Avenue; Critten Lane; and Crocknorth Road or this same route in reverse.

The Order is required to facilitate structural examination works to be carried out by, or on behalf of Inspire (structures) Limited within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 1 night between the hours of 10pm and 6am within the 12 month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 11 October 2021.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed, and the temporary closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access to premises within the affected length of road including access by emergency vehicles to these properties will be maintained by the crew as and when it is required, as will access for pedestrians and cyclists.
