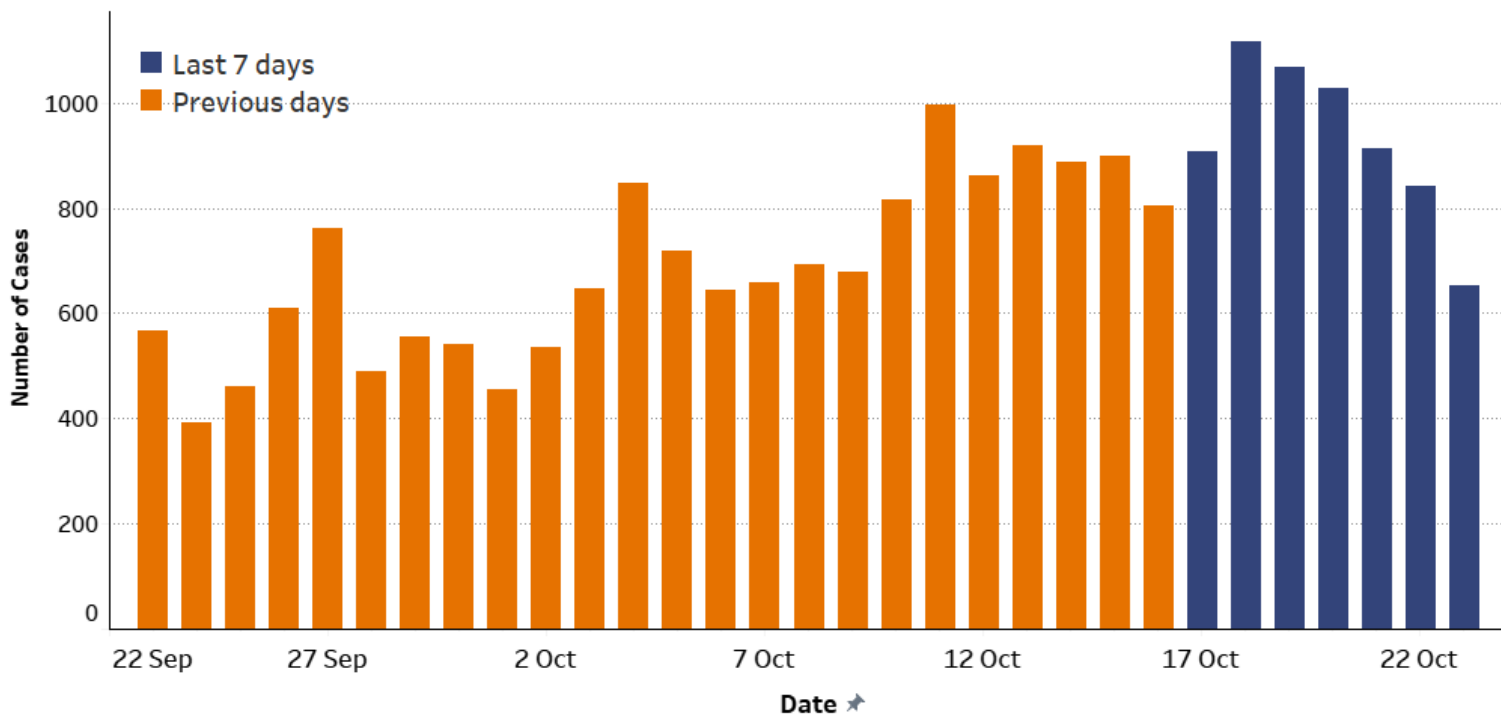

For this reason the data shown is for the seven-day period ending four days prior to the publication date. The rate is calculated daily by Surrey County Council Public Health data intelligence team using the ONS 2019 mid-year population estimates. The 7-day average line on the chart is calculated using the average of cases for three days before, the date itself and the three days after any specific date. The average is not calculated for the most recent three dates as there is not enough data. This is **104** more admissions than the previous week (10 October 2021 to 16 October 2021).

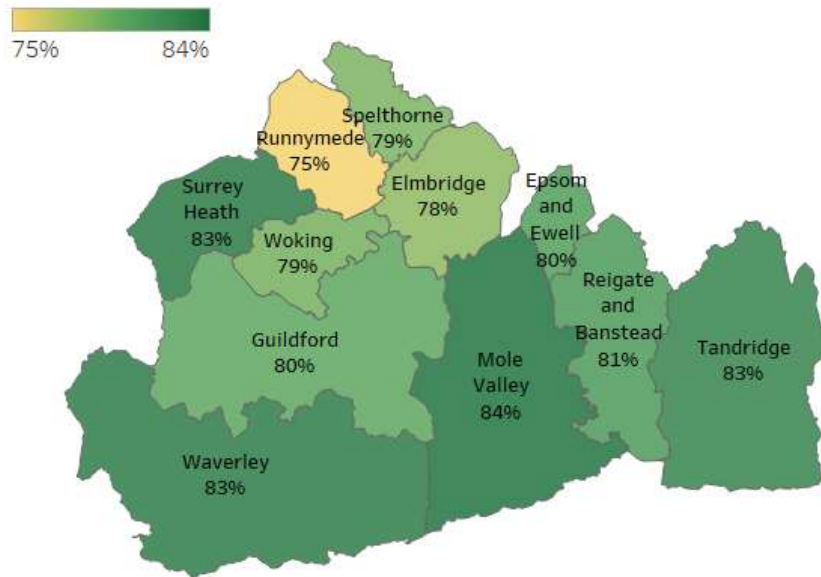

77% of all people in England have had at least 1 dose of a vaccine, and **71%** have had a second dose.

80% of all people in the South East have had at least 1 dose of a vaccine, and **74%** have had a second dose. **77%** of all people in England have had at least 1 dose of a vaccine and **71%** have had a second dose.
