Blackborough Road (B2034) Reigate
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order (No.2) 2021

On 20 October 2021 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) and 14(7) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to –

- (a) prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Blackborough Road (B2034) Reigate as extends from its junction with (D1218) Chart Lane to its junction with (D1249) Crakell Road;
- (b) suspend “The Surrey County Council B2034 Blackborough Road, Reigate Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2021” in its entirety.

Alternative Route – Chart Lane; and Crackell Road or this same route in reverse.

The Order is required to facilitate carriageway trial hole works to be carried out by, or on behalf of Kier within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 5 days between the hours of 7.30am and 5.30pm within the 12 month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 25 October 2021.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed, and the temporary closure and suspension will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access to premises within the affected length of road including access by emergency vehicles to these properties will be maintained at all times, as will access for pedestrians and cyclists.
