Lagham Road (D481) Godstone
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2021

On 20 October 2021 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Lagham Road (D481) Godstone as extends from its junction with (D481) Manor Close to a point in line with the western boundary of No.47 Lagham Road.

Alternative Route – Lagham Road; Easter Way; Harcourt Road; A22 Eastbourne Road; and Lagham Road or this same route in reverse.

The Order is required to facilitate gas mains replacement works to be carried out by, or on behalf of Southern Gas Networks within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 8 days between the hours of 8am and 6pm within the 12 month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 25 October 2021.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure, which is anticipated to be in force 24 hours per day, will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists will be maintained at all times as well access for residents with premises within the closure area. Access for the Emergency Services and all other traffic will be via the signed diversion route.
