Lower Eashing (D90) Godalming
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2021

On 20 October 2021 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Lower Eashing (D90) Godalming as extends from a point in line with the south western boundary of No.2 National Trust Cottages, Lower Eashing to its junction with Public Footpath No. 291 Shackleford.

Alternative Route – The Hollow; Eashing Lane; A283 Guildford Road / Link Road; A3 Milford By-Pass / Guildford-Godalming ByPass Northbound; Elstead Road; Hurtmore Road; A3 Guildford-Godalming ByPass Southbound; and Lower Eashing or this same route in reverse.

The Order is required to facilitate telecoms pole replacement works to be carried out by, or on behalf of BT Openreach within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 2 days between the hours of 8am and 6pm within the 12 month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 28 October 2021.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed, and the temporary closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access to premises within the affected length of road including access by emergency vehicles to these properties will be maintained by the crew as and when it is required, as will access for pedestrians and cyclists.
