**Townpath – Pixham Mill (T8038) Dorking**  
**Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2021**

On 10 November 2021 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Townpath – Pixham Mill (T8038) Dorking that is crossed by the rail over road bridge known as “Lincoln Road Railway Bridge” and for a distance of 15 metres either side.

There is no applicable alternative route.

The Order is required to facilitate railway bridge examination works to be carried out by, or on behalf of Centurion Traffic Management and Network Rail within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 1 night between the hours of 10pm and 6am within the 18 month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 16 November 2021.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed, and the temporary closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access for Residents, Businesses and the Emergency Services will be maintained through the site when safe to do so via a Banksman. Access for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists will be provided by Marshalls if required.
