**Hurst Lane (D3274) Egham**  
**Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order (No.2) 2021**

On 17 November 2021 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Hurst Lane (D3274) Egham as extends from a point in line with the northern boundary of the property known as "The Gables" to a point in line with the southern boundary of the property known as "The Timbers".

There is no applicable alternative route.

The Order is required to facilitate mains water connection works to be carried out by, or on behalf of Affinity Water within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 5 days between the hours of 8am and 5pm within the 12 month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 25 November 2021.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure, which is anticipated to be in force 24 hours per day, will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access to premises within the affected length of road including access by emergency vehicles to these properties will be maintained at all times via the use of Road Plates, as will access for pedestrians and cyclists.
