Bousley Rise (D3052) Ottershaw
Temporary Prohibition of Left Turn Order 2021

On 15 December 2021 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles that are travelling north westwards on (D3052) Bousley Rise from turning left into (C129) Brox Road.

This Temporary Traffic Order is required to allow new mains water repair works to be carried out by, or on behalf of Affinity Water. These works are anticipated to be carried out within 4 days of the 12 month period of operation of this Temporary Order that commences on 20 December 2021.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary prohibitions, which are anticipated to be in force 24 hours per day, will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed.

Access for all traffic will be via the signed vehicular diversion route which will be north west along Brox Road; Murray Road; A320 Guildford Road; and Brox Road.
