Ormonde Road (D3632) Horsell
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2021

On 08 December 2021 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) and 14(7) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to –

- (a) prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Ormonde Road (D3632) Horsell as extends from its junction with (D3630) Rosehill Avenue to its junction with (D3632) Bury Lane.
Alternative Route – Bury Lane; High Street; and Ormonde Road or this same route in reverse; and
- (b) suspend “The Surrey County Council Various Roads In The Borough Of Woking Temporary Prohibition Of Traffic Order (No.2) 2020” in its entirety.

The Order is required to facilitate mains water maintenance and/or repair works to be carried out by, or on behalf of Affinity Water within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 4 days between the hours of 8am and 5pm within the 12-month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 13 December 2021. Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure, which is anticipated to be in operation 24 hours per day, will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed.

Access to premises within the affected length of road including access by emergency vehicles to these properties will be maintained at all times, as will access for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists.
