The Green (Footpath) (D2789) Fetcham
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2022

On 09 February 2022 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit any person from entering or proceeding on foot or by any other means in that length of The Green (Footpath) (D2789) Fetcham as extends from its junction with (D2789) The Green to its junction with (A246) Guildford Road.

The alternative route for pedestrians will be via A246 Guildford Road; B2212 Guildford Road; The Ridgeway; Church Close; and The Green or this same route in reverse.

The Order is required to allow new mains electrical connection works to be carried out by, or on behalf of UK Power Networks within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 4 days between the hours of 8am and 6pm within the 12-month period of operation of the Temporary Order that commences on 15 February 2022.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure, which is anticipated to be in force 24 hours per day, will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. There will be no access maintained through the site whilst works are in progress and all persons will be required to use the diversion route. No sole access will be affected by the closure.
