(D4009) Down Road, and (D4009) Daryngton Drive, Guildford
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2022

On 16 March 2022 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in

- (a) the entire length of Down Road (D4009) Guildford.

There is no applicable alternative route; and

- (b) that length of Daryngton Drive (D4009) Guildford as extends from its junction with (A25) Epsom Road to a point in line with the common boundary between No.140 Epsom Road and No.1 Daryngton Drive.

Alternative Route – (A25) Epsom Road; Holford Road; and Carroll Avenue or this same route in reverse.

The Order is required to allow gas mains replacement and/or maintenance works to be carried out by, or on behalf of SGN within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 6 weeks between the hours of 7.30am and 6.30pm Monday to Friday within the 12-month period of operation of the Temporary Order that commences on 21 March 2022.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure, which is anticipated to be in operation 24 hours per day, will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access to premises within the affected lengths of road including access by emergency vehicles to these properties will be maintained at all times, as will access for pedestrians and cyclists.
