Russ Hill (D323) Charlwood
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2022

On 16 March 2022 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Russ Hill (D323) Charlwood as extends from its junction with the access to the property known as "Fourwinds" to its junction with the access to the property known as "Northlands".

Alternative Route – Russ Hill; Rectory Lane; Norwood Hill Road; Stan Hill; Blanks Lane; Partridge Lane; Charlwood Lane; and Russ Lane or this same route in reverse.

The Order is required to facilitate new mains water connection works to be carried out by, or on behalf of SES Water within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 5 days between the hours of 8am and 5pm within the 12-month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 21 March 2022.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closures and prohibitions, which are anticipated to be in operation 24 hours per day, will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access for pedestrians will be maintained at all times. Access for residents, the emergency services and all other traffic will be via the signed diversion route. No sole access will be affected.
