Lakeside Road (D47) Ash Vale

Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2022

On 03 May 2022 Surrey County Council Made the above-mentioned Temporary Traffic Order under Section 14(1) and 15(8)(b) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“The Act”), the effect of which will be temporarily prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Lakeside Road (D47) Ash Vale as extends from its junction at the roundabout with (D47) Government Road to its junction with (D75) Sopwith Close.

Alternative Route - Government Road; Lakeside Road; Vale Road; Shawfield Road; Aldershot Road; Ash Road; North Lane; and Ordnance Road.

The Order is required to allow for reinstatement of balancing pond works by, or on behalf of Surrey County Council and/or Land and Water Services within the length of road described in this notice. This Temporary Traffic Order commences on 09 May 2022 and continues in force the provisions introduced by “The Surrey County Council Lakeside Road (D47) Ash Vale Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Notice 2022” issued under S14(2) of The Act on 19 April 2022.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed, and the temporary closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Due to the nature of the works, and because of the likelihood of danger to the public there will be no access through the closure area. All traffic will be required to use the signed diversion routes. No sole access will be affected by this closure.

The Council are satisfied that, in accordance with Section 3(2)(a) and 3(2)(b) of The Act, vehicular access to and from premises within the length of road above, or accessible only therefrom may be restricted in order to avoid danger to persons or other traffic using the road and/or preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising
