D6935 Church Road, East Molesey
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2022

On 12 October 2022 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of D6935 Church Road, East Molesey that extends from its junction with D6933 Wolsey Road, to its junction with D6936 Vine Road.

This Traffic Order is required to enable Surrey County Council to carry out installation of a raised table on Wolsey Road at its junction with Church Road and/or resurfacing and/or drainage and/or improvement and/or maintenance and/or footway works. These works are anticipated to be carried out as soon as possible within the 18 month period of operation of this Temporary Order that commences on 17 October 2022, the raised table installation is anticipated to be carried out within a period of 2 days, further works to include footway and drainage works are anticipated to be carried out within a period of 4 weeks. Advanced warning signs will be displayed, and the temporary closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed.

Access for emergency services, pedestrians and, dismounted cyclists and equestrians will be maintained at all times. Access for residents and businesses will be maintained via the vehicular diversion route: - Palace Road, Bridge Road, Riverbank, Hampton Court Way, Creek Road, Bridge Road, Walton Road and Kent Road. Any vehicle found to be obstructing the highway during these works will be removed to a suitable location outside the limits of the works after all reasonable methods have been undertaken to identify and contact the vehicle's owner.
