**Mill Lane (D426) Hurst Green**  
**Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2023**

On 25 January 2023 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Mill Lane (D426) Hurst Green as extends from a point in line with the common boundary between No.124 and No.126 Mill Lane to its junction with (D426) Warren Lane. **Alternative Route** – Warren Lane, Holland Road, Hurst Green Road, Comforts Farm Avenue and Mill Lane or this route in reverse. The Order is required to facilitate new water connection works to be carried out by, or on behalf of SES Water within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 3 days between the hours of 8am and 5pm within the 12-month period of operation of the Temporary Order that commences on 30 January 2023. Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure, which is anticipated to be in operation 24 hours per day, will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access for residents, pedestrians and cyclists will be maintained at all times. Access for the emergency services and all other traffic will be via the signed diversion route.
