The Street (D2644) Fetcham
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2023

On 1 February 2023 Surrey County Council made the above mentioned Temporary Traffic Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of The Street (D2644) Fetcham which extends from its junction with (D2508) Cobham Road to its junction with (D2543) Cock Lane. **Alternative Route** – (D2508) Cobham Road, (D2638) School Lane and (D2644) The Street or this route in reverse. This Order is required to facilitate new water connection works for or on behalf of SES Water. These works are anticipated to be completed over 5 days within 12 month period of operation of this Order which will commence on 13 February 2023.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure, which is anticipated to be in operation 24 hours per day, will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access for residents, pedestrians and dismounted cyclists will be maintained at all times. All other traffic, including the emergency services will be required to use the signed diversion route.
