A248 Kings Road, Shalford
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2022

On 10 August 2022 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of A248 Kings Road, Shalford (also known as Christmas Hill), that extends from its junction with Kings Mews, to the access road to "Lantern House, Christmas Hill".

This Traffic Order is required to enable Surrey County Council to install a pedestrian refuge and/or to carry out surface dressing and/or resurfacing and/or improvement and/or maintenance works. These works are anticipated to be carried out as soon as possible within the 18-month period of operation of this Temporary Order that commences on 15 August 2022. Advanced warning signs will be displayed, and the temporary closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed.

Access for emergency services, pedestrians and, dismounted cyclists and equestrians will be maintained at all times. Access for residents and businesses will be maintained via the vehicular diversion route: - Kings Road, Cranleigh Road, Guildford Road, Church Hill, Guildford Road, Elmbridge Road, Horsham Road, Rooks Hill, Birtley Road, High Street, Horsham Road.

Any vehicle found to be obstructing the highway during these works will be removed to a suitable location outside the limits of the works after all reasonable methods have been undertaken to identify and contact the vehicle's owner.
