














Flags and Glossary in Provider Portal



Early Years Flags and Lozenges

Flag / Lozenge	Meaning	Description
	3–4-Year-Old Universal funding	All 3–4-year-olds are eligible for 15 hours of funding.
	3/4-Year-Old Working Parent Entitlement	Additional 15 hours on top of universal funding for 3–4-year-old whose parents are eligible to claim working parent entitlement.
	3–4-Year-Old Placement Due to reconfirm code	The eligibility code reconfirmation window (D flag) appears one month before the child's eligibility code is due to expire.
	3–4-Year-Old Placement in grace period	The grace period flag appears once the child's eligibility code has expired. Once the code has expired, the child's funding will come to an end the term after the code expired, and the GP flag will remain until this point.
	Eligible for 2 Year Old Funding	2 YO categorised by DfE as 'disadvantaged' and is eligible to claim for funded early education - FEET
	2-Year-Old Working Parent Entitlement	2 YO whose parents are eligible to claim working parent entitlement.
	2-Year-Old Working Parent Placement Due to reconfirm code	The eligibility code reconfirmation window (D flag) appears one month before the child's eligibility code is due to expire.

	<p>2-Year-Old Working Parent Placement in grace period</p>	<p>The grace period flag appears once the child's eligibility code has expired. Once the code has expired, the child's funding will come to an end the term after the code expired, and the GP flag will remain until this point.</p>
	<p>Under 2-Year-Old Working Parent Entitlement</p>	<p>Under 2YO whose parents are eligible to claim working parent entitlement.</p>
	<p>Under 2-Year-Old Placement Due to reconfirm code</p>	<p>The eligibility code reconfirmation window (D flag) appears one month before the child's eligibility code is due to expire.</p>
	<p>Under 2-Year-Old Placement in grace period</p>	<p>The grace period flag appears once the child's eligibility code has expired. Once the code has expired, the child's funding will come to an end the term after the code expired, and the GP flag will remain until this point.</p>
	<p>Early Years Pupil Premium</p>	<p>Child is claiming funded hours and is also eligible for Early Years Pupil Premium funding.</p>
	<p>Disability Assess Funding</p>	<p>Child is eligible for disability access funding.</p>
