

ALLOCATION OF RECEPTION SCHOOL PLACES IN THE BOROUGH OF GUILDFORD FOR SEPTEMBER 2018

The data in this document sets out the reception allocation figures for Surrey's schools in the borough of Guildford as of 16 April 2018. In some cases vacancies remained after the initial allocation to on time applicants and these were filled by applicants who had applied late. Where no measurement is shown, all applicants who applied on time were offered a place. In all other cases measurements relate to the last criterion for which places were offered. All distances quoted are in kilometres.
KEY: PAN = Published Admission Number; **EHCP** = Children with an Education, Health and Care Plan; **LAC & PLAC** = Looked After Children and Previously Looked After Children. * = Schools intending to drop back to PAN; ** = Schools intending to stick above PAN; ~ Consultation underway to close the school

Burpham Foundation Primary School Criteria for 2018 and numbers offered	1 LAC & PLAC. 2 Exceptional medical or social circumstances for whom Burpham Primary is uniquely suitable. 3 Siblings of children on the school's roll at the time of admission, providing the family remains resident at the same address or for whom Burpham Primary School remains the nearest appropriate school. 4 Children of parents expressing a preference for Burpham Primary School.
