SURREY COUNTY COUNCIL in exercise of their powers under Sections 1(1) and 2 (1) to (3) 4(2) 32 35 36 45 46 47 48 49 51 52 and 53 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order: -

Citation and commencement

1 THIS Order may be cited as "The Surrey County Council (Various Roads in Reigate and Banstead) (Amendment of Waiting Loading and Unloading Prohibition and On-Street Parking Places Orders) Order 2019" and shall come into operation on 11 February 2019

Interpretation

- 2 (1) In this Order the expression "enactment" means any enactment whether public general or local and includes any order bylaw rule regulation scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment
- (2) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended applied consolidated re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment
- (3) Unless the context otherwise requires any expression used in this Order which is also used in the amended Order shall have the same meaning as in that Order

Amendment of the Principal Orders

- 3 WITHOUT prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order: -
- (a) The Surrey County Council (Various Roads in Reigate and Banstead) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting Loading and Unloading and Revocation) Order 2013 shall have effect as though for the List of Plans in the Second Schedule to the said Order there was substituted the List of Plans set out in the Sixth Schedule to this Order
- (b) The Surrey County Council (Various Roads in Reigate and Banstead)

(Consolidation of Free Street Parking Places and Revocation) Order 2013 shall have effect as though for the List of Plans in the Schedule to the said Order there was substituted the List of Plans set out in the Sixth Schedule to this Order

- (c) The Surrey County Council (Various Roads in Reigate and Banstead) (Free Street Parking Places) (Disabled Persons) Order 2013 shall have effect as though for the List of Plans in the Second Schedule to the said Order there was substituted the List of Plans set out in the Sixth Schedule to this Order
- (d) The Surrey County Council (Gardens Estate Horley Controlled Parking Zone) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Free Street Parking Places) Order 2013 shall have effect as though for the List of Plans in the Second Schedule to the said Order there was substituted the List of Plans set out in the Sixth Schedule to this Order
- (e) The Surrey County Council (Various Roads in Reigate Controlled Parking Zone) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting, Loading and Unloading and Free Street Parking Places) Order 2013 shall have effect as though for the List of Plans in the Second Schedule to the said Order there was substituted the List of Plans set out in the Sixth Schedule to this Order; and
- (f) The Surrey County Council (Various Roads in Reigate and Banstead) (Residents' On-Street Parking Places) Order 2013 shall have effect as though: -
 - (i) for the List of Plans in the Second Schedule to the said Order there was substituted the List of Plans set out in the Sixth Schedule to this Order;
 - (ii) In Article 2 for the word "carriageway" and the meaning attributed to it there was substituted the following –

"highway" is a way over which there exists a public right of passage, that is to say a right for all Her Majesty's subjects at all seasons of the year freely and at their will to pass and repass without let or hindrance and means the whole or a part of a highway other than a ferry or waterway, and includes bridges and tunnels which the highway passes over/ through
 - (iii) wherever the word "carriageway" appears in the said Order there was substituted the word "highway"
 - (iv) For the First Schedule to the said Order there was substituted the First Schedule set out in the Second Schedule to this Order
- (g) The Surrey County Council (Various Roads in Redhill Controlled Parking Zone) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting Loading and Unloading and Free Street Parking Places) Order 2013 shall have effect as though

- (i) for the List of Plans in the Second Schedule to the said Order there was substituted the List of Plans set out in the Sixth Schedule to this Order
