(VARIOUS ROADS IN ELMBRIDGE)
(RESIDENTS' ON-STREET PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2014 (AMENDMENT
NO.6) ORDER 2019

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SURREY COUNTY COUNCIL in exercise of their powers under Sections 32 35 36 45 46 49 51 and 53 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order: -

Citation and commencement

1 THIS Order may be cited as "The Surrey County Council (Various Roads in Elmbridge) (Residents' On-Street Parking Places) Order 2014 (Amendment No.6) Order 2019" and shall come into force on 11th March 2019

Interpretation

2 (1) In this Order the expression "the Order of 2014" means The Surrey County Council (Various Roads in Elmbridge) (Residents' On-Street Parking Places) Order 2014

(2) In this Order the expression "enactment" means any enactment whether public general or local and includes any order bye-law rule regulation scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment

(3) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended applied consolidated re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment

(4) Unless the context otherwise requires any expression used in this Order which is also used in the Order of 2014 shall have the same meaning as in that Order

Amendment of the Order of 2014

3 WITHOUT prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in

respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order the Order of 2014 shall have effect as though –

- a) for the First Part of the First Schedule to the Order of 2014 there was substituted the First Schedule set out in the First Schedule to this Order
- b) for the Second Schedule to the Order of 2014 there was substituted the Second Schedule set out in the Second Schedule to this Order
- c) for the First Schedule to the Order of 2014 there were added the Third Part set out in the Third Schedule to this Order
- d) in Part IV of Section I of the Arrangement of Articles there were substituted the following Section –

“SECTION I

- e) in Article 2 (1) of the Order of 2014 there were added the following expressions

–

“ “business premises” has the same meaning as in Regulation 1 of Part II of Schedule 3 of the Town and Country Planning (Control of Advertisements) Regulations 1982 (S. I. 1982/666)

“business user” means a person who occupies business premises for business purposes the postal address of which is within the roads or lengths of roads specified in Column 2 of the Second Part of the First Schedule”

f) for Article 3 in the Order of 2014 there was substituted the following similarly numbered Article –

“Designation of such parking places

3 Each area on a highway comprising the lengths of carriageway of a road specified in Column 3 of the table forming the First Part of the First Schedule and identified on the Plans as a resident’s only on-street parking place (excluding the areas marked by a black broken line and labelled as a Controlled Parking Zone) for use on such days and during such hours as identified on the plans by such classes of vehicles as are specified in Article 4 and bounded on one side of that length by the edge of the carriageway and having a width throughout of not less than 1.83 metres is hereby designated as a resident’s parking place”

g) for Article 4 in the Order of 2014 there was substituted the following similarly numbered Article –

“Manner of standing in such a parking place

4 The driver of a vehicle waiting in a resident’s only on-street parking place during the permitted hours in accordance with the foregoing provisions of this Order shall cause it so to stand: -

(a) in the case of a parking place in relation to which special provisions as to the manner of standing of a vehicle in that parking place are identified on the plans (excluding the areas marked by a black broken line and labelled as a Controlled Parking Zone) so as to be in accordance with those provisions

(b) in the case of any other parking place –

(i) if the said parking place is not in a one-way road that the left or near side or right off side of the vehicle is parallel to the edge of the carriageway nearest to the vehicle or

(ii) if the said parking place is in a one-way road that the left or near

side of the vehicle is adjacent to the left-hand edge of the carriageway or that the right or off side of the vehicle is adjacent to the right-hand edge of the carriageway

(iii) that the distance between the edge of the carriageway and the nearest wheel of the vehicle is not more than 300 millimetres

(c) in the case of any parking place that is not marked on the carriageway –

(i) that the vehicle does not obstruct in any way whatsoever the passing and re-passing of all traffic (including pedestrians) on the highway which comprises the parking place or any part thereof and

(ii) the vehicle is adjacent to the edge of the carriageway on the side of the highway on which the vehicle is waiting

(d) every part of the vehicle is within the limits of a parking space and/or a parking place

(e) that no part of the vehicle obstructs any vehicular means of ingress to or egress from any premises adjacent to the side of the road on which the vehicle is waiting”

h) for Article 11 in the Order of 2014 there was substituted the following similarly numbered Article –

“Manner of waiting in such a parking place

11 NO person shall cause or permit a vehicle to wait in a resident’s only on-street parking place by virtue of the provisions of sub-paragraph (1) (e) f) (g) (h) (i) or (j) of the last preceding Article otherwise than so that:

(a) in the case of a resident’s on-street parking place in relation to which special provisions as to the manner of standing of a vehicle in that parking place are identified on the plans (excluding the areas marked by a black broken line and labelled as a Controlled Parking Zone) so that the vehicle shall stand

- (i) unless the length of the vehicle precludes compliance with this sub-paragraph in accordance with those provisions and so that every part of the vehicle is within the limits of the aforesaid parking place or
 - (ii) if the length of the vehicle does preclude compliance with the last preceding sub-paragraph so that the longitudinal axis of the vehicle is parallel to the edge of the carriageway nearest to the vehicle and the distance between the said edge and the nearest wheel of the vehicle is not more than 300 millimetres and
 - (b) in the case of any other parking place that is marked on the carriageway that the longitudinal axis of the vehicle is parallel to the edge of the carriageway nearest to the vehicle and the distance between the said edge and the nearest wheel of the vehicle is not more than 300 millimetres
 - (c) in the case of any parking place that is not marked on the carriageway –
 - (i) that the vehicle does not obstruct in any way whatsoever the passing and re-passing of all traffic (including pedestrians) on the highway which comprises the parking place or any part thereof and
 - (ii) the vehicle is adjacent to the edge of the carriageway on the side of the highway on which the vehicle is waiting
 - (d) so that no part of the vehicle obstructs any vehicular means of ingress to or egress from any premises adjacent to the side of the road on which the vehicle is waiting”
- i) for Article 17 in the Order of 2014 there was substituted the following similarly numbered Article –

“Manner of waiting in such a parking place

17 The driver of a vehicle waiting in a shared use parking place during the permitted hours in accordance with the foregoing provisions of this Order shall

cause it so to stand:-

- (a) in the case of a shared use parking place in relation to which special provisions as to the manner of standing of a vehicle in that parking place are identified on the plans (excluding the areas marked by a black broken line and labelled as a Controlled Parking Zone) so as to be in accordance with those provisions
- (b) in the case of any other shared use parking place –
 - (i) if the said parking place is not in a one-way road that the left or near side or right off side of the vehicle is parallel to the edge of the carriageway nearest to the vehicle or
 - (ii) if the said parking place is in a one-way road that the left or near side of the vehicle is adjacent to the left-hand edge of the carriageway or that the right or off side of the vehicle is adjacent to the right-hand edge of the carriageway
 - (iii) that the distance between the edge of the carriageway and the nearest wheel of the vehicle is not more than 300 millimetres
- (c) in the case of any parking place that is not marked on the carriageway –
 - (i) that the vehicle does not obstruct in any way whatsoever the passing and re-passing of all traffic (including pedestrians) on the highway which comprises the parking place or any part thereof and
 - (ii) the vehicle is adjacent to the edge of the carriageway on the side of the highway on which the vehicle is waiting
- (d) every part of the vehicle is within the limits of a parking space and/or a parking” place
- (e) that no part of the vehicle obstructs any vehicular means of ingress to or egress from any premises adjacent to the side of the road on which the vehicle is waiting”

j) for Article 23 in the Order of 2014 there was substituted the following similarly numbered Article –

“Manner of waiting in such a parking place

23 NO person shall cause or permit a vehicle to wait in a shared use parking place by virtue of the provisions of sub-paragraph (1) (e) (f) (g) (h) (i) or (j) of the last preceding Article otherwise than:

(a) in the case of a shared use parking place in relation to which special provisions as to the manner of standing of a vehicle in that parking place are identified on the plans (excluding the areas marked by a black broken line and labelled as a Controlled Parking Zone) so that the vehicle shall stand

(i) unless the length of the vehicle precludes compliance with this sub-paragraph in accordance with those provisions and so that every part of the vehicle is within the limits of the aforesaid parking place or

(ii) if the length of the vehicle does preclude compliance with the last preceding sub-paragraph so that the longitudinal axis of the vehicle is parallel to the edge of the carriageway nearest to the vehicle and the distance between the said edge and the nearest wheel of the vehicle is not more than 300 millimetres and

(b) in the case of any other shared use parking place that is marked on the carriageway that the longitudinal axis of the vehicle is parallel to the edge of the carriageway nearest to the vehicle and the distance between the said edge and the nearest wheel of the vehicle is not more than 300 millimetres

(c) in the case of any parking place that is not marked on the carriageway –

(i) that the vehicle does not obstruct in any way whatsoever

the passing and re-passing of all traffic (including pedestrians) on the highway which comprises the parking place or any part thereof and

- (ii) the vehicle is adjacent to the edge of the carriageway on the side of the highway on which the vehicle is waiting
- (d) so that no part of the vehicle obstructs any vehicular means of ingress to or egress from any premises adjacent to the side of the road on which the vehicle is waiting

For the purposes of the last foregoing paragraph the expression “premises” shall not include any premises to or from which any furniture is being removed by virtue of the provisions of sub-paragraph (1)(g) of the last preceding Article or to or from which goods are being delivered or collected by virtue of the provisions of sub-paragraph (1)(h) of that Article”

- k) for Article 29 in the Order of 2014 there was substituted the following similarly numbered Article –

“Application for and issue of a resident’s parking permit

29 (1)(a) Any resident who is the owner of a vehicle of the following class that is to say a passenger vehicle or a goods vehicle or a motor cycle may apply to the Borough Council in accordance with the following provisions for the issue to him of a resident’s parking permit or a virtual resident’s parking permit in respect of that vehicle and any such application shall be made in a paper or electronic form provided by the Borough Council and shall be accompanied by a remittance for the appropriate fee in respect of a resident’s parking permit hereinafter specified

(b) The number of resident’s parking permits that may be issued by the Borough Council in respect of each separate place of abode shall be calculated using the formula contained in Column 2 of the table in the

Third Part of the First Schedule as relates to the relevant Permit area as indicated in Column 1 thereof subject to the discretion of the Borough Council

PROVIDED that where the Council or Borough Council is of the opinion that the off-street parking space is large enough for the leaving of a motor car or goods vehicle or any number of those vehicles or a combination thereof but cannot be used for that purpose due to alternative use being made of that space by any member of the household then the Borough Council may count the number of such off-street parking spaces in the calculation for the total number of residents' parking permits to be issued to any resident of that particular place of abode

- (2) The Council may at any time require an applicant for a parking permit or any parking permit holder to produce to an officer of the Council such evidence in respect of an application for a parking permit made to them as they may reasonably call for to verify any particulars or information given to them or in respect of any parking permit issued by them to that person as they may reasonably call for to verify that the parking permit is valid
- (3) Upon receipt of an application duly made –
 - (a) under the provisions of paragraph (1) of this Article in respect of the first nominated vehicle the Council upon being satisfied that the applicant is a resident and is the owner of a vehicle of the classes specified in paragraph (1) of this Article may in its absolute discretion issue to the applicant therefor one parking permit the parking permit being for the leaving without time limit during the permitted hours in such residents' parking place or shared use parking place within the lengths of roads indicated in Column 3 of the table forming the First Part of the First Schedule

as relates to the usual place of abode of the applicant as indicated in Column 2 of the said table of the vehicle to which such parking permit relates by the owner of such vehicle or by any person using such vehicle within the consent of the owner other than person to whom such vehicle has been left for hire or reward

- (b) under the provisions of paragraph (1) of this Article in respect of the second nominated vehicle (where applicable) the Council upon being satisfied that the applicant is a resident and is the owner of a vehicle of the classes specified in paragraph (1) of this Article may in its absolute discretion issue to the applicant therefor one parking permit the parking permit being for the leaving without time limit during the permitted hours in such residents' parking place or shared use parking place within the lengths of roads indicated in Column 3 of the table forming the First Part of the First Schedule as relates to the usual place of abode of the applicant as indicated in Column 2 of the said table by the owner of such vehicle or by any person using such vehicle with the consent of the owner other than a person to whom such vehicle has been let for hire or reward
- (4) Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of paragraph (1) of this Article the Council shall not in any circumstances issue a resident's parking permit to any resident which would be valid for any period during which any other parking permit issued to that resident by the Council or the Borough Council for the leaving of a vehicle in a street parking place pursuant to the provisions of any other enactment is valid
- (5) If the Council is either unable or decides not to issue a parking permit to an applicant therefor any remittance paid shall be refunded to the said applicant

(6) The fee referred to in paragraph (1) of this Article payable to the Council shall be the sum of –

(a) fifty pounds in respect of a resident's parking permit issued under the provisions of paragraph (3) (a) of this Article in respect of the first nominated vehicle which subject to the provisions of this Order shall be valid for a period of twelve months running from any day of the month on which the parking permit first becomes valid

(b) seventy-five pounds in respect of a resident's parking permit issued under the provisions of paragraph (3) (b) of this Article in respect of the second nominated vehicle which subject to the provisions of this Order shall be valid for a period of twelve months running from any day of the month on which the parking permit first becomes valid

(7) It is hereby stated by the Borough Council that –

(a) the issuing of a resident's parking permit to a resident's parking permit holder does not guarantee that any parking space within the resident's parking place or shared use parking place will be available for use by the resident's parking permit holder aforesaid during the permitted hours and

(b) the resident's parking permit remains at all times whilst it is issued to a parking permit holder the property of the Council"

l) for Article 30 in the Order of 2014 there was substituted the following similarly numbered Article –

"Surrender withdrawal and validity of resident's parking permits

30 (1) A resident's parking permit holder may surrender a resident's parking permits or a virtual resident's parking permit to the Council at any time and shall surrender it to the Council on the occurrence of any

one of the events set out in paragraph (3) of this Article or in accordance with the provisions of paragraph (5) of this Article

(2) The Council may by notice served on a resident's parking permit holder sent by either recorded delivery service to that person at the address shown by person on the application for the resident's parking permit or at any other address believed to be that person's place of abode or by electronic means in the case of a virtual resident's parking permit withdraw a resident's parking permit if it appears to the Council that any one of the events set out in paragraph (3) (a) (b) (d) (e) or (f) of this Article has occurred and that person shall surrender the parking permit to the Council within 48 hours of the receipt of the aforementioned notice

(3) The events referred to in the foregoing provisions of this Article are –

(a) the resident's parking permit holder ceasing to be a resident

(b) the resident's parking permit holder ceasing to be the owner of the vehicle in respect of which the parking permit was issued

(c) the withdrawal of the resident's parking permit by the Council under the provisions of paragraph (2) of this Article

(d) the vehicle in respect of which the resident's parking permit was issued being adapted or used in such a manner that it is not a vehicle of a class specified in paragraph (1) of Article 21

(e) the resident's parking permit having been obtained by fraud and/or deception of as a result of incorrect material

information supplied by the applicant therefor

- (f) the resident's parking permit bearing a letter other than that indicated by the Council pursuant to the provision of paragraph (1) of Article 2 relating to a parking permit
 - (g) the issue of a duplicate resident's parking permit by the Council pursuant to the provisions of Article 31
 - (h) the resident's parking permit ceasing to be valid pursuant to the provisions of paragraph (4) of this Article
- (4) Without prejudice to the foregoing provisions of this Article a resident's parking permit shall cease to be valid at the expiration of the period stated thereon or on the occurrence of any one of the events set out in paragraph (3) of this Article whichever is the earlier
- (5) where a resident's parking permit is issued pursuant to paragraph (3) of Article 21 to any person upon receipt of a cheque and the cheque is subsequently dishonoured the resident's parking permit shall cease to be of any effect and the Council shall by notice served on the person whom such a parking permit was issued send by either recorded delivery service to that person at the address shown by that person on the application for the resident's parking permit or any other address believed to be that person's place of abode or by electronic means in the case of a virtual resident's parking permit requiring that person to surrender the resident's parking permit Council within 48 hours of the receipt of the aforementioned notice"

m) for Article 31 in the Order of 2014 there was substituted the following similarly numbered Article –

“Application for and issue of duplicate parking permits

- 31 (1) If a resident’s parking permit is mutilated or torn or accidentally defaced or the figures or particulars thereon have become illegible or the colour of the resident’s parking permit has become altered by fading or otherwise the resident’s parking permit holder shall either surrender it to the Council or apply to the Council for the issue to him of a duplicate parking permit and the Council upon receipt of the resident’s parking permit shall issue a duplicate resident’s parking permit so marked and upon such issue the first mentioned parking permit shall become invalid
- (2) if a resident’s parking permit is lost or destroyed the parking permit holder may apply to the Council for the issue to him of a duplicate parking permit and the Council upon being satisfied as to such loss or destruction shall issue a duplicate resident’s parking permit so marked and upon such issue the first mentioned resident’s parking permit shall become invalid
- (3) The provisions of this Order shall apply to a duplicate resident’s parking permit and an application therefor as if it were a resident’s parking permit or, as the case may be, an application therefor
- (4) The charge for the issue of a duplicate resident’s parking permit shall be fifteen pounds for each duplicate resident’s parking permit or cashless parking device issued pursuant to paragraph (1) or paragraph (2) of this Article”

n) for Article 32 in the Order of 2014 there was substituted the following similarly numbered Article –

“Application for the re-issue of a residents parking permit upon a change of vehicle with a different registration mark

32 WHERE a resident or a resident’s parking permit holder applies for the issue of a further resident’s parking permit due to that resident or that parking permit holder changing the vehicle in respect of which the original resident’s parking permit was issued so that the original resident’s parking permit no longer bears the registration mark of the vehicle in respect of which that original resident’s parking permit was first issued under the provisions of paragraph (3) of Article 21 then the original resident’s parking permit shall be surrendered to the Council or the Borough Council and immediately a further resident’s parking permit will be issued to that resident or resident’s parking permit holder bearing the registration mark of the new vehicle

PROVIDED THAT there shall then be payable to the Council or the Borough Council a sum of fifteen pounds for the issue of that further resident’s parking permit which shall be valid for the remainder of the period stated on the original resident’s parking permit under the provisions of paragraph (a) (ii) of Article 25”

o) for Article 33 in the Order of 2014 there was substituted the following similarly numbered Article –

“Form of resident’s parking permits

33 A resident’s parking permit shall either –

- (a) be in writing and shall include the following particulars: -
 - (i) the registration mark of the vehicle in respect of which the parking permit has been issued and
 - (ii) the period during which subject to the provisions of paragraph (3) of Article 29 the parking permit shall remain valid and

- (iii) an indication that the parking permit has been issued by the Borough Council and
- (iv) the words "Resident Parking Permit" and an indication as to which area to the resident parking permit relates
- (v) a serial number identifiable in the office of issue or
- (b) be a cashless parking device or
- (c) be a virtual resident's parking permit"

p) for Article 34 in the Order of 2014 there was substituted the following similarly numbered Article –

"Display of resident's parking permits

34 AT all times during which a vehicle of a class specified in paragraph (1) of Article 29 is left in the resident's parking place or a shared use parking place pursuant to Article 21 during the permitted hours a valid resident's parking permit shall either –

- (a) be displayed on the vehicle in respect of which it was issued on the front or near side of the vehicle so that all the particulars on the resident's parking permit are readily visible from the front or near side of the vehicle or
- (b) be a virtual parking permit that is recorded by the hand held device in respect of a vehicle

PROVIDED THAT in respect of a vehicle which is validated by the hand held device as having a valid virtual parking permit, no parking permit needs to be displayed on that vehicle

AND FURTHER PROVIDED THAT no such resident's parking permit cashless parking device or virtual parking permit is required if the vehicle is waiting in such a parking place pursuant to the provisions of Article 10 or is displaying in the manner specified in Articles 38 42 44 or 49 a valid parking permit issued

in respect of that vehicle or is a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position or in the prescribed manner a disabled person's badge issued by any local authority"

q) for Article 35 in the Order of 2014 there was substituted the following similarly numbered Article –

"Refund of fee paid in respect of a resident's parking permit

35 (1) A resident's parking permit holder who surrenders a resident's parking permit to the council before the resident's parking permit becomes valid shall be entitled to a refund of the fee paid in respect thereof

(2) A resident's parking permit holder who surrenders a resident's parking permit to the council after the resident's parking permit has become valid shall be entitled to a refund of part of the charge paid in respect thereof calculated in accordance with the provisions of the next following paragraph

(3) The part of the charge which is refundable under the provisions of the last foregoing paragraph shall be calculated as one-twelfth of the sum paid in respect thereof in respect of each complete month of the period specified thereon as the period during which it shall be valid which remains unexpired at the time when the resident's parking permit is surrendered to the Council"

r) in Article 38 in the Order of 2014 for the words "Articles 38 42 44 or 49" there were substituted the words "Articles 34 42 44 or 49"

s) in paragraph (1) (c) of Article 45 in the Order of 2014 for the words "Resident Area A B C D E F G H I J K or L" there were substituted the words "the length of road specified in Column 3 of the table forming the First Part of the First Schedule and identified"

t) in paragraph (3) of Article 45 in Order of 2014 for the words "the area shown

marked by a black broken line and labelled as Resident Area A B C D E F G H I J K or L” there were substituted the words “the length of road specified in Column 3 of the table forming the First Part of the First Schedule and identified”

u) in Article 49 in the Order of 2014 for the words “Article 39(E)” there were substituted the words “Article 45”

v) for Article 52 in the Order of 2014 there was substituted the following similarly numbered Article –

“Saving with respect to parking places

52 INsofar as any provision contained in Part II conflicts with a provision which is contained in The Surrey County Council (Various Roads in Elmbridge) (Revocation and Consolidation of Waiting Loading and Unloading Prohibition and Restriction) Order 2014 or in any other enactment existing at the time when this Order comes into operation and which imposes or has the effect of imposing any restriction or prohibition on –

- (a) the waiting loading and/or unloading by vehicles and/or
- (b) the delivering or collecting of goods by vehicles
- (c) or grants an exemption from any such restriction or prohibition

then the provisions contained in that Order or any other enactment as applicable shall prevail

PROVIDED THAT nothing in this Article shall apply in respect of a bus stop clearway”
