**The Surrey County Council**  
**Balcombe Gardens (D346) Horley**  
**Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2021**

On 01 September 2021 Surrey County Council Made the above mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Balcombe Gardens (D346) Horley as extends from its junction with a point in line with the western boundary of No.51 Balcombe Gardens to a point approximately 25 metres east along (D346) Balcombe Gardens.

There is no applicable alternative route.

The Order is required to allow new electrical connection works to be carried out by, or on behalf of UK Power Networks within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 5 days between the hours of 9am and 5pm within the 12 month period of operation of the Temporary Order that commences on 13 September 2021.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure, which is anticipated to be in operation 24 hours per day, will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access to premises within the affected length of road including access by emergency vehicles to these properties will be maintained at all times, as will access for pedestrians and cyclists.
