Dartmouth Avenue (D3672) Sheerwater
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2021

On 21 July 2021 Surrey County Council Made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Dartmouth Avenue (D3675) Sheerwater as extends from its junction with (X4007) St Lukes Court to a point in line with the north eastern boundary of No.53 Dartmouth Avenue.

The alternative route will be via Dartmouth Avenue; and Devonshire Avenue.

The Order is required to facilitate new mains water connection works to be carried out by, or on behalf of Affinity Water within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 1 month between the hours of 8am and 5pm within the 12 month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 26 July 2021.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure, which is anticipated to be in operation 24 hours per day, will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access for residents, businesses, the emergency services, pedestrians, and cyclists will be maintained at all times.
