Water Lane (D6859) Cobham
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2021

On 22 September 2021 Surrey County Council Made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Water Lane (D6859) Cobham as extends from a point in line with the north eastern boundary of No.22A Water Lane to a point in line with the south western boundary of No.20 Water Lane.

Alternative Route – Water Lane; Knipp Hill; Miles Lane; Fairmile Lane; and Water Lane or this same route in reverse.

The Order is required to facilitate new mains electrical connection works to be carried out by, or on behalf of UK Power Networks within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 5 days within the 12 month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 27 September 2021.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure, which is anticipated to be in operation 24 hours per day, will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access to premises within the affected length of road will be maintained at all times, as will access for pedestrians and cyclists. All other traffic including emergency service vehicles will be required to use the signed diversion route.
