Holmbury Road (D276) Ewhurst
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2021

On 27 October 2021 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Holmbury Road (D276) Ewhurst as extends from a point in line with the southern boundary of the property known as "Greenoak" to a point approximately 550 metres northwards along (D276) Holmbury Road.

Alternative Route – Holmbury Road; Holmbury Hill Road; Pitland Street; Horham Road; Miles Hill; Cotton Row; Ockley Road; and Holmbury Road or this same route in reverse.

The Order is required to facilitate water mains reinforcement works to be carried out by, or on behalf of Morrison Utility Services and Thames Water within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 4 days within the 12 month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 01 November 2021.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure, which is anticipated to be in operation 24 hours per day, will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access to premises within the affected length of road will be maintained at all times via road plates. All other traffic including the emergency services will be required to use the signed diversion route.
