Fairmile Lane (C157) Cobham
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2021

On 01 December 2021 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Fairmile Lane (C157) Cobham as extends from a point in line with the northern boundary of No.6 Fairmile Lane to a point in line with the southern boundary of No.2 Fairmile Lane.

Alternative Route – Fairmile Lane; Leigh Hill Road; and A245 Stoke Road or this same route in reverse.

The Order is required to facilitate electrical connection works to be carried out by, or on behalf of UKPN within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 5 days between the hours of 8pm and 6pm within the 12 month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 06 December 2021. Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure, which is anticipated to be force 24 hours per day, will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed.

Access to premises within the affected length of road including access by emergency vehicles to these properties will be maintained at all times, as will access for pedestrians and cyclists.
