The Smithers (D2853) and Oakdene Close (D2849), Brockham
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2021

On 10 November 2021 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in the following lengths of road –

- (a) the entire length of The Smithers (D2853) Brockham; and
- (b) the entire length of Oakdene Close (D2849) Brockham.

There are no applicable alternative routes.

This Order, which will commence on 23 November 2022 for a period of 12 months is required because works are being, or are proposed to be, executed on or near the said roads, to be carried out by or on behalf of SES Water, including but not limited to: new water mains installation works.

The works in part (a) are anticipated to be carried out over 11 weeks between the hours of 8am and 4pm commencing 23 November 2021. The works in part (b) are anticipated to be carried out over 18 weeks between the hours of 8am and 4pm commencing 04 January 2022.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closures, which are anticipated to be in force 24 hours per day, will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access to premises within the affected length of road including access by emergency vehicles to these properties will be maintained when safe to do so, as will access for pedestrians and cyclists.

During certain phases of the works, vehicular access to premises may be restricted, when this is the case such restriction of access will apply for no more than eight hours within any 24-hour period.
