Prune Hill (D1391) Englefield Green
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2021

On 24 November 2021 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Prune Hill (D1391) Englefield Green as extends from its junction with the access to the property known as “Rusham Cottage” to its junction with the eastern access to the property known as “Wentworth Park”.

Alternative Route – Prune Hill; Whitehall Lane; Stroude Road; Trumps Green Road; Wellington Avenue Callow Hill; Bakeham Lane; and Prune Hill.

The Order is required to facilitate new chamber installation and/or new ductwork installation works to be carried out by, or on behalf of BT Openreach within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 2 weeks between the hours of 8am and 6pm within the 12 month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 02 December 2021.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure, which is anticipated to be force 24 hours per day, will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access to premises within the affected length of road including access by emergency vehicles to these properties will be maintained by the crew as and when required, as will access for pedestrians and cyclists.
