**Temporary Prohibition of Waiting Loading and Unloading Order 2021**

On 22 December 2021 Surrey County Council made the above mentioned Temporary Order under Sections 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit waiting, loading, and unloading at any time, by vehicles on both sides of the carriageway in that length of The Street (C52) Capel as extends from its junction with (X52) Nuns Field to a point in line with the northern boundary of No.110 The Street, also known as "The Joinery".

This Temporary Order is required to facilitate telecoms utility duct works by or on behalf of BT Openreach. These works are anticipated to be completed within 3 days of the 12 month period of operation of this Order which commences on 10 January 2022.

The temporary restriction, which is anticipated to be in force 24 hours per day, will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed and only to such extent as indicated by those traffic signs.

Exemptions apply for vehicles when waiting because they are required by law to stop, are obliged to stop in order to prevent an accident or are prevented from proceeding because of circumstances outside the drivers control and in respect of anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or of a civil enforcement officer will apply when the temporary restrictions are in force.

(N.B. Disabled persons displaying a disabled blue badge will not be exempt from the temporary waiting restriction).
