**Knowle Lane (D184) Cranleigh**  
**Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2022**

On 19 January 2022 Surrey County Council made the above mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Knowle Lane (D184) Cranleigh as extends from its junction with the access to the property known as “Bridge Farm” to its junction with the access to the property known as “Waterland Cottage”.

Alternative Route – Knowle Lane; High Street; Elmbridge Road; Alfold Road; A281 Guildford Road; Wildwood Lane; and Knowle Lane or this same route in reverse.

This Order, which will commence on 24 January 2022 for a period of 18 months is required because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the said roads, to be carried out by or on behalf of Surrey County Council, including but not limited to: bore hole investigation works and/or bridge replacement and/or bridge maintenance works.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure, which is anticipated to be in operation 24 hours per day, will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Due to the nature of the works and for reasons of safety there will be no access through the works area, all traffic will be required to use the diversion route listed above. No sole access will be affected.
