Clockhouse Lane (B3003) Ashford
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2022

On 02 February 2022 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Clockhouse Lane (B3003) Ashford as extends from its junction with (D3254) Reedsfield Road to its junction with (D3253) Parkland Road.

Alternative Route – Clockhouse Lane; Feltham Road; Church Road; Stanwell Road; A30 London Road; and Clockhouse Lane or this same route in reverse.

The Order is required to facilitate mains water repair and/or maintenance works to be carried out by, or on behalf of Affinity Water within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 3 days between the hours of 8.30am and 4pm within the 12-month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 11 February 2022.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure, which is anticipated to be in operation 24 hours per day, will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access to premises within the affected length of road including access by emergency vehicles to these properties will be maintained at all times, as will access for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists.
