Knipp Hill (D6855) Cobham
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2022

On 23 February 2022 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Knipp Hill (D6855) Cobham as extends from its junction with (D6855) Water Lane to its junction with (D6855) Pony Chase.

Alternative Route – Knipp Hill; Miles Lane; Fairmile Lane; and Water Lane or this same route in reverse.

The Order is required to facilitate utility asset works to be carried out by, or on behalf of SES Water within the lengths of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 9 days between the hours of 8am and 5pm within the 12-month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 28 February 2022.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closures and prohibitions, which are anticipated to be in operation 24 hours per day, will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access for residents, pedestrians and dismounted cyclists will be maintained at all times. Access for the emergency services and all other traffic will be via the signed diversion route.
