Overford Drive (D922), and Summerlands (D942), Cranleigh
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2022

On 04 May 2022 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of

- (a) Overford Drive (D922) Cranleigh as extends from its junction with (D922) Manor Gardens to its junction with (D922) Charts Close.
Alternative Route – Overford Drive; Horsham Road; Hitherwood; and Overford Drive or this same route in reverse; and
- (b) Summerlands (D942) Cranleigh as extends from its junction with (X3023) Kiln Copse to its junction with (D942) Barnfield.
Alternative Route – Summerlands; Slip of Wood; Acres Platt; Sherrydon; and Summerlands or this same route in reverse.

The Order is required to allow mains water replacement works to be carried out by, or on behalf of Morrison Utility Services and/or Thames Water within the lengths of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out as soon as possible over 2 weeks between the hours of 7am and 7pm within the 12-month period of operation of the Temporary Order that commences on 09 May 2022.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure, which is anticipated to be in operation 24 hours per day, will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access for residents, the emergency services, pedestrians, and cyclists will be maintained at all times.
