

**Notice**  
**The Surrey County Council**  
**Various Roads in Tatsfield and Titsey**  
**Temporary Prohibition of Traffic and Speed Limit Order 2023**

On 1 February 2023 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to temporarily

(1) prohibit any vehicle from entering or proceeding in that length of Beddlestead Lane (C76) Warlingham as extends from its junction with Clarks Lane (B2024) Warlingham to Pitchers Copse Farm (X45035) Chelsham

Alternative route – Clarks Lane, Limpsfield Road, Beech Farm Road, Hesiers Hill and Beddlestead Lane

(2) prohibit vehicles from driving or proceeding at a speed greater than 30 miles per hour in the lengths of road in the following lengths of road: -

(a) that length of Clarks Lane (B2024) Tatsfield as extends from a point 136 metres west of its junction with (D446) White Lane to a point 200 metres east of its junction with (D446) Tatsfield Approach Road

(b) that length of Tatsfield Approach Road (D446) Tatsfield as extend from its junction with (B2024) Clarks Lane to a point 195 metres northwards along Tatsfield Approach Road

(c) that length of White Lane (D446) Titsey as extends from its junction with (B2024) Clarks Lane to a point 165 metres south along White Lane

This Order is required to enable electrical connection works to be carried out by, or on behalf of ALS Civil Engineers Ltd within the length of roads described in this notice.

These works are anticipated to be carried out over 5 days between the hours of 8am and 6pm within the 12-month period of operation of this Temporary Order which commences on 20 February 2023. Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure and speed limit, which are anticipated to be in operation 24 hours per day, will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed

The speed limit imposed by this Order shall not apply to vehicles used by special forces in accordance with the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011; or in respect of anything done with the permission or at

the direction of a police constable in uniform; or in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by traffic signs placed on the highway by or on behalf of the Police.

Access for residents, the emergency services, pedestrians, and dismounted cyclists will be maintained at all times. All other traffic will be required to use the signed diversion routes.
