D76 Wharf Road, Ash Vale
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2023

On 08 February 2023 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of D76 Wharf Road, Ash Vale that extends from its junction with B3411 Ash Hill Road, to its junction with Balmoral Road.

This Traffic Order is required to enable BT Openreach to carry out gully cleaning and/or ducting and/or cabling and/or installation and/or maintenance works. These works are anticipated to be carried out between the hours of 8am and 4pm, within 1 day of the 12-month period of operation of this Temporary Order that commences on 19 February 2023. Advanced warning signs will be displayed, and the temporary closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed.

Access for emergency vehicles, residents, businesses, pedestrians, cyclists, and equestrians will be maintained at all times under direction of site operatives.

Alternative route: - Wharf Road, Vale Road, Heath Vale, Hutton Road, and Prospect Road.
