

**Notice**  
**The Surrey County Council**  
**D3716 Blackness Lane, Woking**  
**Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2023**

On 08 February 2023 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) and (7) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to: -

1. Prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in the entire length of D3716 Blackness Lane, Woking.
2. Suspend the "Surrey County Council Blackness Lane (D3716) Woking Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2022" in its entirety.

This Traffic Order is required to enable KN CIRCET/Traffic Control 123 Limited to lay track and/or carry out utility connection and/or maintenance works. These works are anticipated to be carried out between the hours of 8am and 6pm, within 3 days of the 11 month period of operation of this Temporary Order that commences on 13 February 2023. Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed.

There is no applicable vehicular diversion route however access for emergency services, residents, businesses, pedestrians, cyclists and equestrians will be maintained at all times.
