

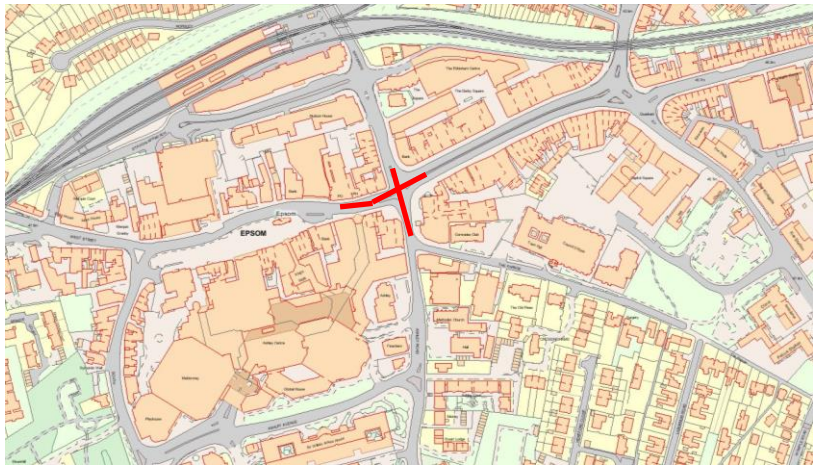

What are we going to do?

We will be undertaking work to improve the traffic signals and pedestrian crossing at the Spread Eagle Junction.

The junction will remain open during these works, however there may be some delays.



Works area —

Information for residents and businesses

This phase of the improvements to the town centre will renew the traffic signals at the Spread Eagle Junction, at the pedestrian crossing at the Ashley Centre access and at the crossing by Derby Square. As the pedestrian crossings at the Ashley Centre and Spread Eagle are some of the most used in the town centre they will also have pedestrian count down markers so pedestrians can see how long they have to cross.

The traffic island in the cross roads will also be removed and the footway built out at the Metro Bank corner. This will be paved with the same blocks as recently used in South Street footways and outside the Playhouse. The pedestrian crossing between this corner and the Spread Eagle will also be fully controlled making it safer than the existing crossing which has had an unfortunate history of pedestrian accidents.

We will also be resurfacing the area, this will require some night time works with road closures. We will advise local businesses and residents when we have programmed the works.

Delays in work

Our work is sometimes delayed by bad weather. We will keep you updated on any changes via the advance warning signs.

Noise

There will be some noise but we will try to keep this to a minimum.
