Littleheath Lane (D6855) Cobham
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2020

On 09 December 2020 Surrey County Council (“The Council”) Made the above mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act (“The Act”) 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Littleheath Lane (D6855) Cobham that is crossed by the Cooks Level-Crossing and for a distance of 20 metres either side.

The Order is required to allow maintenance and/or repair works to be carried out by, or on behalf of Network Rail within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 2 nights between the hours of 11pm and 3am within the 18 month period of operation of the Temporary Order that commences on 16 January 2021.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed, and the temporary closure, which is anticipated to be in operation 24 hours per day, will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access for the emergency services, residents, pedestrians and dismounted cyclists will be maintained at all times, all other traffic will be required to follow the signed diversion route. The vehicular diversion route will be via Littleheath Lane; Water Lane; Fairmile Lane; Stoke Road; and Blundell Lane or this same route in reverse.
