Burgh Wood (D1009) Banstead
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2021

On 08 September 2021 Surrey County Council Made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Burgh Wood (D1009) Banstead as extends from its junction with (A217) Brighton Road to its junction with (D1008) Green Curve.

Alternative Route Northbound – A217 Brighton Road; A022 Fir Tree Road; Nork Way; East Gate; Green Curve.

Alternative Route Southbound – A217 Brighton Road; Tattenham Way; Reigate Road; Nork Way; and Green Curve.

The Order is required to facilitate gas mains replacement works to be carried out by, or on behalf of Forefront Utilities within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 6 weeks between the hours of 7am and 5pm within the 12 month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 20 September 2021.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure, which is anticipated to be in operation 24 hours per day, will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access to premises within the affected length of road will be maintained at all times, as will access for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists. Access for the emergency services and all other traffic will be via the signed diversion routes.
