Knapp Road (D3251) Ashford
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2021

On 04 August 2021 Surrey County Council Made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in the following lengths of road –

- (a) that length of Knapp Road (D3251) Ashford as extends from its junction with (B378) Church Road to its junction with (D3251) Village Way; and
- (b) that length of Knapp Road (D3251) Ashford as extends from its junction with (D3251) Knapp Road to the entrance to Clarendon Primary School.

Alternative Routes: Clockwise – Church Road; Brownrigg Road; and Village Way.

Anticlockwise – Village Way; Parkland Grove; and Church Road.

The Order is required to facilitate new barrier pipe installation works to be carried out by, or on behalf of Herts Traffic Management within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 24 days between the hours of 8am and 5pm within the 12 month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 10 August 2021.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed, and the temporary closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access for residents within the closure area, the emergency services, pedestrians, and cyclists will be maintained at all times.
