

## **NOTICE**

### **The Surrey County Council Elmbridge Road (B2130) Cranleigh Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2021**

On 29 September 2021 Surrey County Council Made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of the northbound carriageway of Elmbridge Road (B2130) Cranleigh as extends from its junction with the access to "Repaircraft" to its junction with (X11267) Hewitts Road.

Alternative Route – Elmbridge Road; A281 Horsham Road / Guildford Road / Horsham Road / Guildford Road; Church Street; Cox Green; Horsham Road; High Street; The Common; and Elmbridge Road or this same route in reverse.

This Order, which will commence on 11 October 2021 for a period of 12 months is required because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the said roads, to be carried out by or on behalf of Surrey County Council, including but not limited to: traffic signal refurbishment works. Works are anticipated to be carried out over 5 nights between the hours of 7pm and 5am.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed; and the temporary closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Any vehicle found to be obstructing the highway during these works will be removed to outside the limits of the works after all reasonable methods have been undertaken to identify and contact the vehicle's owner. Access for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists will be maintained at all times, Due to the nature of the works and for the safety of works operatives and the public there will be no vehicular access through the closure area. All vehicles will be required to use the signed diversion route.
