Blackheath Lane (D211) Wonersh
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order (No.3) 2021

On 27 October 2021 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) and 14(7) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to –

- (a) prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Blackheath Lane (D211) Wonersh as extends from a point in line with the south western boundary of the property known as “Rose Cottage” to its junction with the access to the property known as “Garden Cottage”; and
- (b) suspend “The Surrey County Council D211 Blackheath Lane, Wonersh Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order No.2 2021” insofar as it affects the length of road described in part (a).

Alternative Route – Blackheath Lane; Wonersh Common; A248 New Road / Dorking Road; Sample Oak Lane; and Blackheath Lane or this same route in reverse.

The Order is required to facilitate telecoms utility works to be carried out by, or on behalf of BT Openreach within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 5 days between the hours of 9am and 5.30pm within the 12 month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 01 November 2021.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed, and the temporary closure and suspension will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access to premises within the affected length of road including access by emergency vehicles to these properties will be maintained by the crew as required. All other traffic will be required to use the signed diversion route.
